On June 20, Crisis Magazine published an online article whose headline grabbed my attention: "First Reaction of Teenage Boys to the Traditional Latin Mass". Written by a Catholic high school religion teacher, the author explains that for the past few years he has been giving a rather ingenious assignment to all of his students - boys from families who attend the Novus Ordo - during their junior year: "to attend either the Mass of another Catholic Rite or the Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite, and to describe their experience, writing what was the same or different and their honest reactions to it."



For me, it forced me to examine my conscience." These are but a small sample of student reactions after attending their first Traditional Mass.
