

Fr. Karl Stehlin, District Superior of the Society of St. Pius X (SSPX) in Poland, explains how priests and faithful in Poland and across Eastern Europe are flocking to Tradition. In an inspiring interview, he explains how 13 priests have found refuge with the SSPX in Poland and how the number of faithful has tripled in the past year. He explains that the COVID restrictions (which are more strict on churches than under Communism), the novelties of the current papacy, and *Traditionis Custodes* have led many priests and faithful to Tradition thanks to the protection of the Immaculata.
