


Yesterday, CFN's Matt Gaspers joined Kennedy Hall to discuss the contents of Gaspers' latest article series, "Is Francis the True Pope? Revisiting the Debate". Part 1 of the series appears in the February 2024 edition of CFN, while Part 2 will appear in the March 2024 edition.

In Part 1 of his two-part series, Gaspers examines some common arguments of those who hold that Pope Benedict XVI did not validly resign the office of Supreme Pontiff.
