The problem for Trump is that the men (and women) he is dealing with don't seem to share his outlook.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky and the EU's top technocrat Ursula von der Leyen seem intent on prolonging the conflict. Both have demanded a ceasefire, which they know Putin won't agree to.

Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni knows a ceasefire is a non-starter. She was caught rolling her eyes while German Chancellor Friedrich Merz lectured Trump at the White House about the need for one instead of seeking an immediate lasting peace.
